What options are available?

- Semester abroad: study abroad in Semester 1 or 2* of your 2nd year (NUMed, Newcastle University Malaysia). *Biomedical Sciences degree only in Sem 2
- Summer placement abroad: take a summer research placement overseas between your 2nd and 3rd years
- Year abroad: study for an entire year abroad between 2nd and 3rd year
- Stage 3 project abroad: conduct your final year research project overseas

FAQs

When do I apply? Applications open in November and close in early January (for mobility the following academic year)..

Can I do more than one exchange? As there are limited places available, multiple exchanges are not possible, however it can be possible to do a semester each in two different locations, or other informal overseas options.

Is it expensive? Realistically it can be expensive due to costs of flights, visas, accommodation and general travel, however applicants may be entitled to funding:
