Periodicals: Introduction

Definition: “A *periodical* is any title published at regular intervals but with each new part containing new information”. Typically newspapers, magazines and journals:-

- Daily: e.g. *Lloyd's List*, e.g. *The Times*. Our collection holds none.
- Weekly: e.g. *Fairplay Shipping Weekly*.
- Monthly/bimonthly, e.g. *The Naval Architect* by RINA. e.g. *The Motor Ship*.
- Quarterly: e.g. *The Mariner's Mirror*.
- Annual: e.g. *Journal of Commerce and Shipping Telegraph: Annual Review*.

For convenience our holdings are divided in to three main types:- magazines, journals, and statistical and market reports:-

- **Magazines:** in our Collection they are typically trade and industry technical magazines published monthly and containing short articles (1 paragraph – 2 pages) summarising current news about ships and shipping. As distinct from, say, hobby or travel magazines. Most news is in the form of editorial articles (i.e. written or edited by an editor employed by the magazine) which are often summaries of interviews with, or press releases from, trade and industry about their new products and services, together with advertisements:-
 - **Commercial magazines:** published by commercial publishers (e.g. *The Shipbuilder*)
 - **Learned society magazines:** published by professional learned societies (e.g. *The Naval Architect* by RINA (Royal Institution of Naval Architects)), containing details of their own professional activities together with a mix of trade and industry news.
 - **House journals:** published by companies or organisations primarily as advertising about their own activities (e.g. *MacGregor News*).
- **Journals:** typically research journals published quarterly and containing substantial and detailed papers of 10+ pages:-
 - **Commercial journals:** published by commercial publishers (e.g. **International Journal of Maritime History IJMH**). Typically the papers have not been presented at a meeting prior to publication. Our holdings include only a few years of IJMT and no other commercial journals!
 - **Learned society journals:** published by professional learned societies (e.g. NECIES). In the past many of these papers would have been written by members, presented and read at a society meeting and then published in the society's *Transactions* or *Proceedings* with discussions – the records of their meetings (e.g. *Transactions. North East Coast Institution of Engineers and Shipbuilders*).
- **Statistical/market reports:** typically they are periodical (e.g. quarterly or annual) compiled and published by commercial publishers or other organisations. Their contents is mostly statistical information (e.g. *LR World Fleet Statistics*) or market research analysis. Sometimes they are published as a one-off report with no further editions.

Periodicals: holdings (only trade and industry technical magazines, research journals)

Holdings in our Collection include about 70 ship and marine titles which contain a mix of news articles and research papers. Most of the titles are published in Britain but some are foreign. The holdings generally stop at 2000 even if the periodical continues after this date.
