### Ship and marine engine trial records: Introduction

An important aspect of new ships and engines being accepted by owners from the builders, as fit for purpose, was a series of trials to demonstrate that the contract specifications had been achieved such as speed, power, capacity, etc. Ships would undergo "measured mile" speed trials at sea under defined conditions.
